Organizations use DaaS to reduce IT costs through:

- Subscription models, which offer flexibility to pay for what you need on an ongoing basis.⁶
- Simplified monthly budget planning and forecasting with predictable pricing.
- Rapid provisioning which gets employees up and running quickly.
- Fewer hardware expenses by supporting and managing BYOD (bring your own device) programs.







Remote work means exposing your company's data to countless security risks. And sometimes workers find themselves outside the protected LAN, where they connect in public areas like coffee shops and airports.

DaaS addresses these challenges by shifting the device and security management into an enterprise or cloud data center. This regularly backed up and highly-protected environment is where a DaaS provider loads the software and operating systems the workforce needs to work safely from any location and any device.

Keep organizations safe with DaaS by:

- Protecting against intruders should a device get lost or stolen through multi-factor authentication (MFA), and encryption also secures sensitive data while it is in transit.⁶
- Providing centralized management, dashboards and reporting, which strengthens user compliance with company policies.
- Separating personal applications from enterprise applications on BYOD endpoints.
- Storing corporate data on the server, rather than on local machines.
- Leveraging logging and auditing, which tracks usage and mitigates potential security issues.



DaaS Facilitates Business Continuity



In times of uncertainty or emergency, DaaS allows organizations and their employees to be productive and ease into remote operations safely and securely.

Case in point, COVID-19 was a wake-up call for many organizations, as they found themselves disrupted without warning. In just a matter of weeks or even days, they scrambled to implement work-from-home and e-learning strategies for employees and students. Many organizations, especially schools, dealt with decreasing laptop supplies and workers⁷ used unsecured personal devices, opening cybersecurity risks and leaving many end users with poor hardware performance.

Worldwide public cloud services are expected to grow 6.3% in 2020 to a total of \$257.9 billion, up from \$242.7 in the previous year. And DaaS is expected to have the most significant growth, increasing 95.4% to \$1.2 billion.8

DaaS improves business continuity by:

- Restoring data via centralized data backups in the case of failures or cyberattacks.
- Protecting organizations against data loss or data breach by disallowing access through rolebased security.
- Storing corporate data on the server, rather than on local machines.
- Ensuring critical data, applications, and unified communications tools are accessible from any location and on any device.
